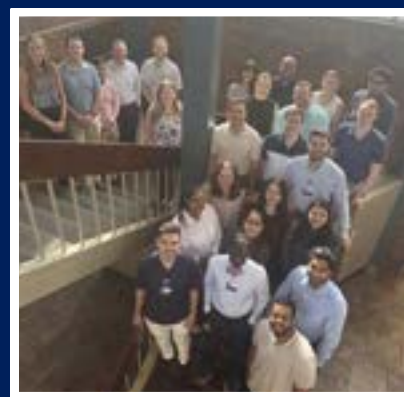
## Graduating Class of 2025

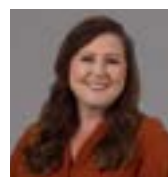
