

Department of Earth Sciences: Physical Geography Instructor Position

The University of South Alabama Department of Earth Sciences invites applications for a full-time (12-month), non-tenure-track Instructor position in Physical Geography, starting August 15, 2023. The minimum education requirement to apply is a master's degree in Geography or a closely related field at the time of appointment. A candidate with experience teaching in a class or lab setting and skills with GIS or Remote Sensing will be preferred. The candidate will assume responsibility for directing Physical Geography lab operations and potentially teaching an upper division class focusing on the candidate's specialties. The candidate selected for this position must meet eligibility requirements to work legally in the United States.
