- Topic: Charisma, and the political and economic impact



John Antonakis is Professor of Organizational Behavior at the University of Lausanne, Switzerland, and former Editor-in-Chief of *The Leadership Quarterly*. He holds a Ph.D. from Walden University and completed a postdoctoral fellowship at Yale. His research focuses on charisma, leadership predictors, and research methods, with publications in *Science*, *Psychological Science*, *Academy of Management Journal*, and *Harvard Business Review*. The Web of Science identifies him as a Highly Cited Scientist in Business and Economics, and he ranks in the world's top 2% of scientists in his field. He is a fellow of the Academy of Management and multiple other scholarly societies.
