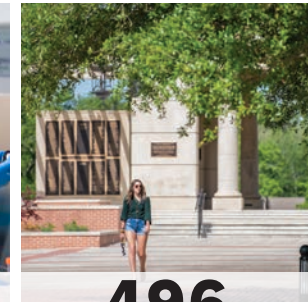

- 1 APPLY ONLINE**

- 2 SUBMIT TEST SCORES AND TRANSCRIPTS**  
Unofficial copies can be sent, but official copies are required before enrollment.
- 3 NOTIFICATION OF ACCEPTANCE**  
You will be notified to check your admissions portal for application status.
- 4 LOG INTO PAWS AND JAGMAIL**  
Visit SouthAlabama.edu/international/orientation for these links. Your admission letter will include your J number – use this to sign in.
- 5 FILL OUT HOUSING CONTRACTS**  
If you choose to live on campus, visit SouthAlabama.edu/myUSAhousing.
- 6 PRE-ORIENTATION AND ORIENTATION**  
Prior to orientation, you should submit immunization records and complete online orientation modules.
- 7 FLIGHT UPDATES**  
Sign up for arrival pickup from Mobile Regional Airport.
- 8 ACADEMIC ADVISING**  
Your advisor will contact you to schedule an advising appointment after you complete orientation registration.
- 9 REGISTER FOR CLASSES**  
During your advising appointment, you will register for classes.

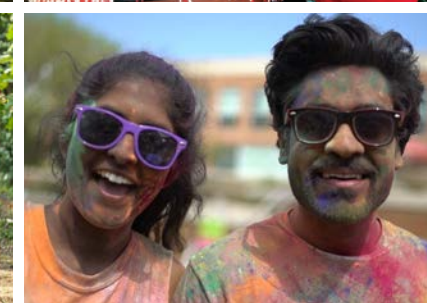
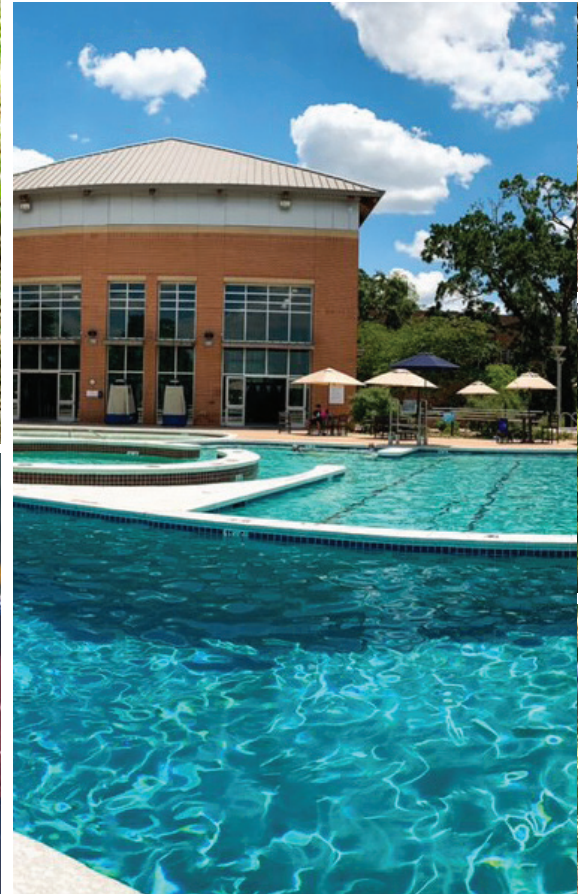
